# Bred-by-Exhibitor (BBE) Class eligibility

All dogs entered in the Bred-By class must be individually registered with the AKC The Person handling the dog must be breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog.

To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

## Non-Regular Classes - Involving Multiple Dog Entries

As the judge's decisions in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Entries are based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

**Stud Dog Class** - For a Stud Dog and two of his Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Get must be entered in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes (other than Stud Dog). The Stud Dog to be shown in the ring with the Get, but the class to be judged based on the merits of the Get. **Brace Class**. For two dogs having at least one common owner(s), irrespective of sex. Dogs compromising a Brace must be named in "Additional Entry" portion of the entry form. If a dog that is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class it must be entered for "Brace Class Only". In making entries for "Brace Class Only", full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated "Brace No. 1", Brace No. 2", etc.

- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
