A short club meeting will be held at noon, floor will be open for additional nominations for Board and Officers.

Event #1 – Fun Field Trial – 8:30am-1200pm

Hounds are taken into the fenced enclosure to search for rabbit and hare. This is a test of the hounds searching and scenting skills as the pack of experienced and novice hounds seek out their quarry in the rabbit's natural habitat. Grounds can be wet, and briars are to be expected, so appropriate clothing and footwear are advised.

Event #2 – Fun Conformation Match – 1:00pm – 2:30pm

In this event the skills of handling and presenting your hound for others to observe are accented. It is an event showcasing the proper structure and movement of a hound as judged by an experienced breeder of the Bassets. Puppy and Regular classes will be offered.

Event #3 – Fun Obedience Match – 2:30pm – 4:00pm

In this event, the teamwork skills of the handler and hound are judged against a standard of expected performance. Scoring on a variety of exercises that showcase the hound's ability and willingness to perform a set schedule of choreographed tasks. Classes offered can be on lead or off lead for more experienced. Classes to be offered will be Pre-Novice, Novice and Open.
